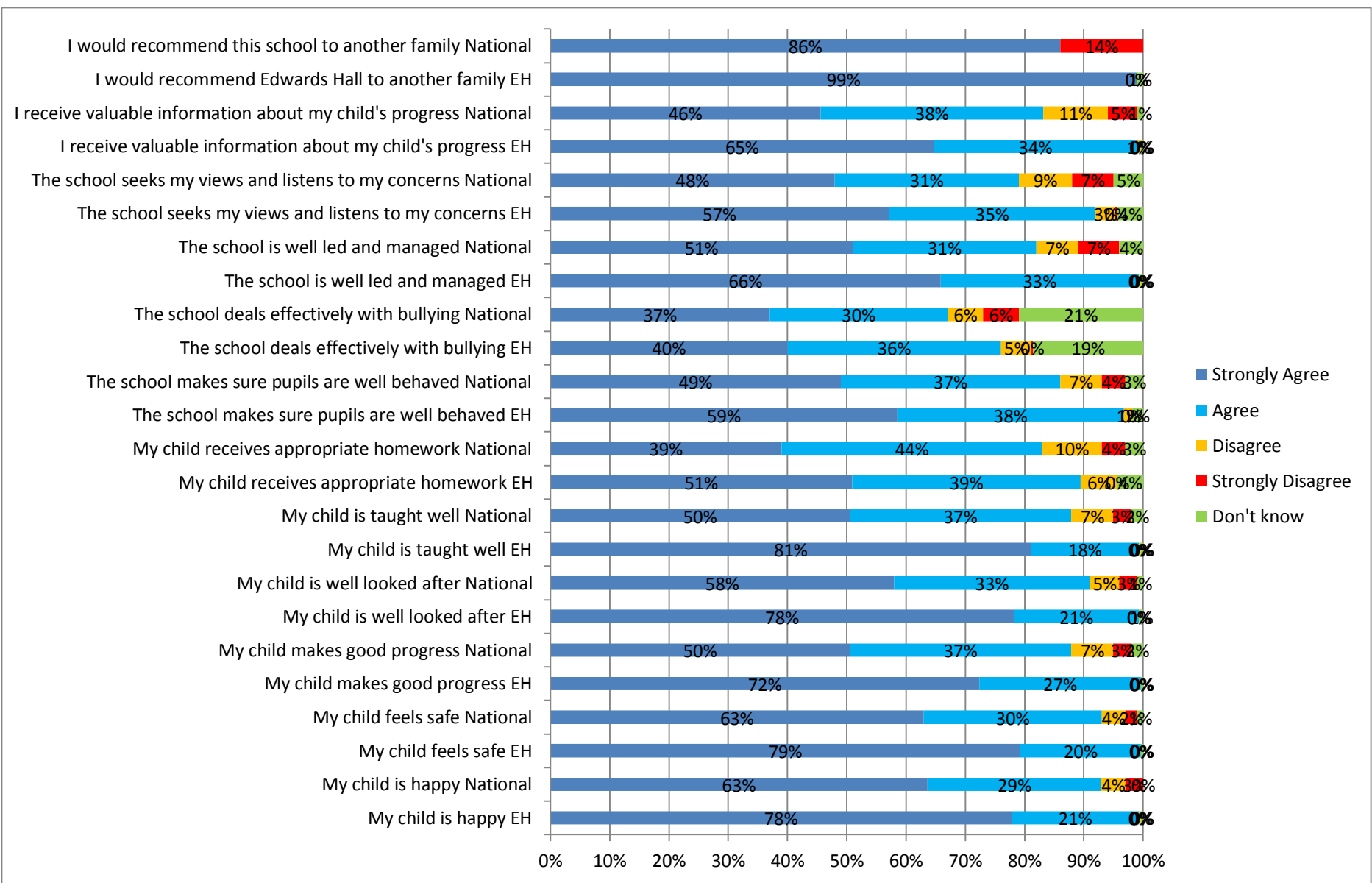

Outcomes from the Parent Survey compare very favourably with national data.

100% of parents say that their child feels safe and makes good progress.

99% would recommend the school to another family compared to 86% national.

99% feel that the school is well managed compared to 82% nationally.

81% of parents strongly agreed that their child is well taught compared to 50% nationally.

Areas to consider

6% of parents do not feel that the homework is appropriate. Comments indicated that some felt it was too much, others too little, some felt that it was too challenging or too time consuming.

5% disagreed with the statement that the school deals effectively with bullying while none strongly disagreed. This figure nationally is 12%. However, it is still an area that we need to follow up.
