



This term our topic in Year 4 is called "Walk like an Egyptian." The children will shortly be exploring mummification planning asking questions which they would like to explore.

As Historians and Geographers they will be looking at the Ancient Egyptians (one the earliest civilizations). They will be finding out about how the Ancient Egyptians fit in with other ancient civilizations then go on to study their achievements in greater depth focusing on what can be discovered about their lifestyle and technologies. As part of their learning we are arranging a trip to the British Museum so that children will be able to explore first-hand the artefacts and artwork of the Ancient Egyptians.

As Artists they will be using their sketch books to record observations of artefacts and artwork as starting points for their own two and three dimensional artworks. The children will also have opportunity to improve their skills in art and design techniques, including drawing and sculpture.

In our PSHE and P4C this term we will be looking at the theme of New Beginnings. In RE, they will be exploring what is meant by worship and why religious people come together to worship. They will also explore and reflect on the concept of pilgrimage.

As scientists we will be exploring electricity. Building on the work finding out about Nikola Tesla we will be investigating simple circuits and what makes them work as well as finding out about conductors and insulators.
