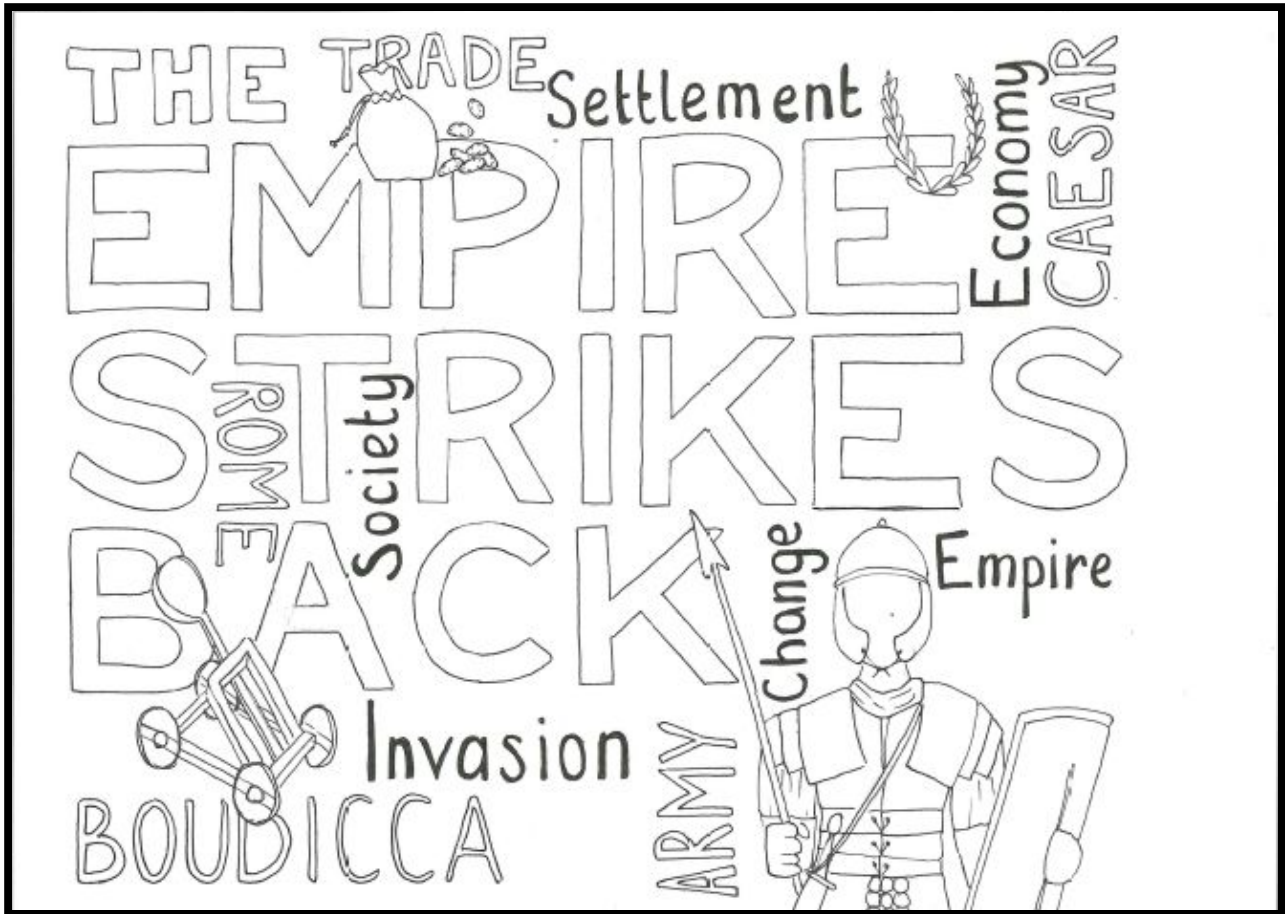


Year 4 Summer Term 2018



“The Empire Strikes Back”

The Romans invade and change the face of Britain.

As Historians we will be studying the history of the local area and the impact of the Roman Empire on England. We will be exploring the ways in which the arrival of the Roman Empire changed life, technology and beliefs in the UK.

We will link this to our Geography skills by learning to locate the world's countries using atlases, globes and digital mapping. We will explore key physical and human characteristics including settlements, land use, trade, and the distribution of natural resources. In our Literacy work we will exploring some traditional Roman tales, using them as a model to write our own.

As Scientists we will explore living things and their habitats learning how to group living creatures in a variety of ways. We will research the ways that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. We will discover the exciting facts about different states of matter and how some materials change state when

they are heated or cooled. We will build upon our measuring skills to explore some of the temperatures at which changes of state occur.

As designers we will begin exploring Roman Chariots and will develop our construction skills to design, make and evaluate them.
