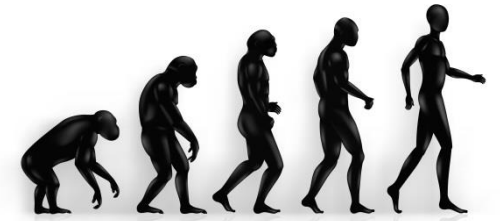


Year 6 Summer 2018



As Historians, we will be studying elements of Chinese history with a particular focus on the Shang Dynasty. We will be looking at where in China the Dynasty was located, as well studying various aspects of their cultures and beliefs.

As Scientists, we will be exploring how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways (in China and other parts of the world) and that adaptation may lead to evolution. We will also be learning how living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago; the lives of Mary Anning and Charles Darwin, and the impact of their findings, will be explored.

As Artists, we will be investigating Chinese Brush painting and how artists use simple strokes of a paint brush to capture a single object or an entire scene; we shall then be creating our own Chinese Brush paintings.

As Geographers, we will be studying how aspects of our local area have evolved over time and will consider how they may develop in the future.

In PE, we will be linking our map work in Geography to the sport of orienteering. We will be completing a course within the school ground as well as making use of the local environment to really test our map-reading skills.

Please note that, as the children are busy working hard towards their SATs tests, there will be no homework project until after half term.
