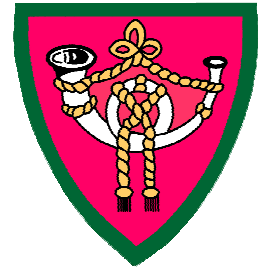

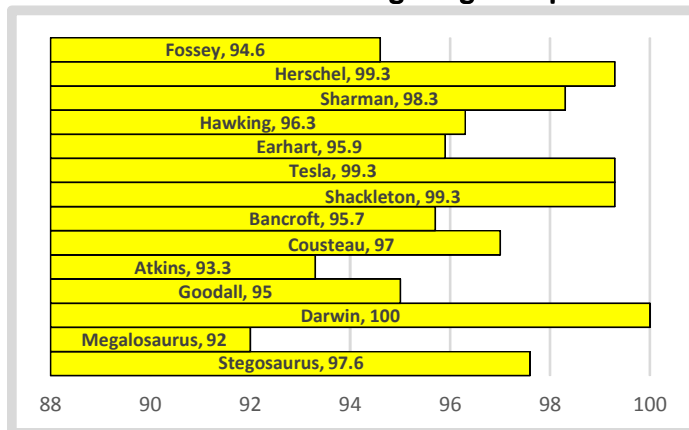
Parents found the time very helpful and said "It was good to speak with other parents too".
