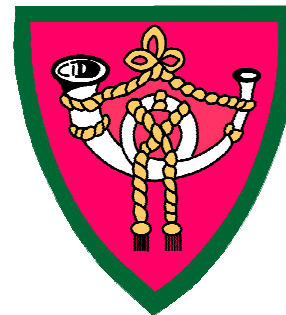

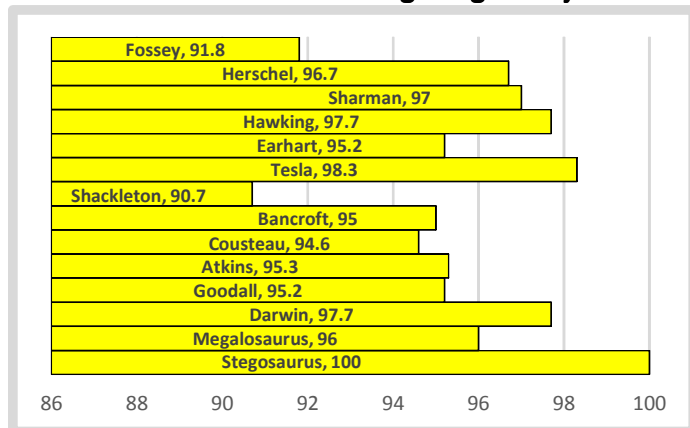

After finishing 2nd in the Southend 3 Tees competition, we were invited to the county final this week.

We took part in matches against Cressing, Chipping Ongar and Lawford. Our first match was extremely close and we were unlucky to lose by just 1 run but bounced back in our second game, winning with our highest score of the day with 44 runs. The final game was decided by Lawford scoring two sixes which took them to 43 against our total of 36.

Coming 3rd in our group, we then went on to play Henry Moore, Downham and George Tomlinson to decide the 9th to 12th places. We lost our first game, drew the second and finished the last game with a tense finish and another 1 run difference, but this time we won! The children represented the school superbly and had a fantastic time. Well done to all involved!
