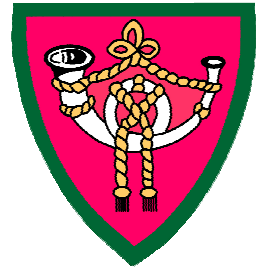

Summer Term Diary Dates

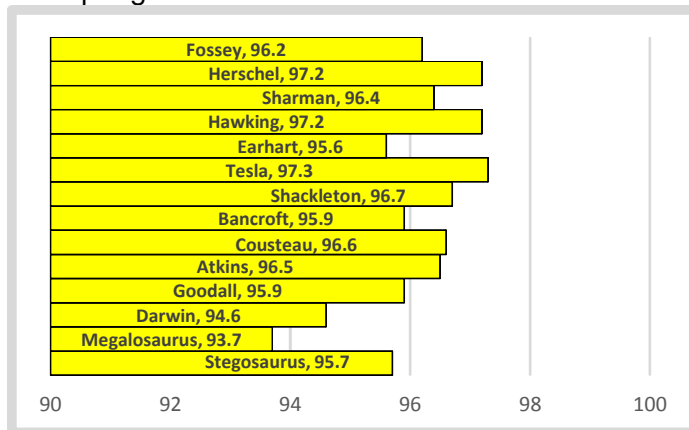


We are currently finalising the list of Summer Term dates for your diary.
