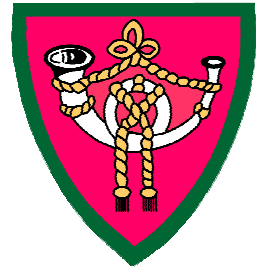

We have activities arranged throughout the week and a finale of science shows for all years on Friday 8th June which will be run by The Royal Institution (www.rigb.org).

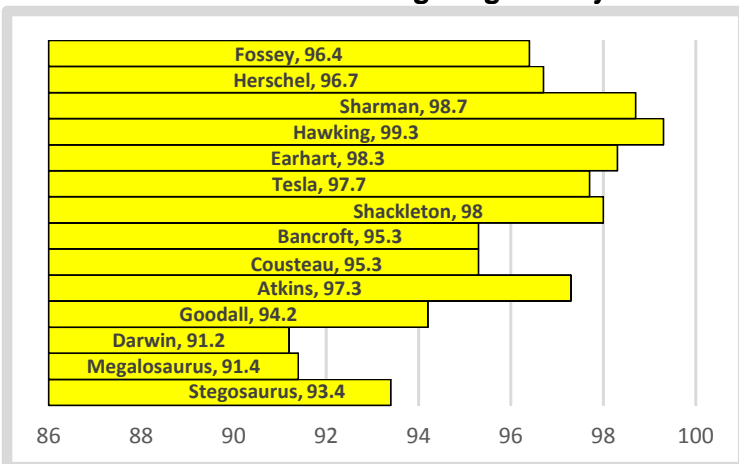
