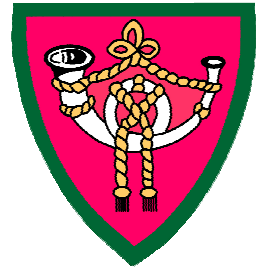

Monday Morning Club Years 1-3



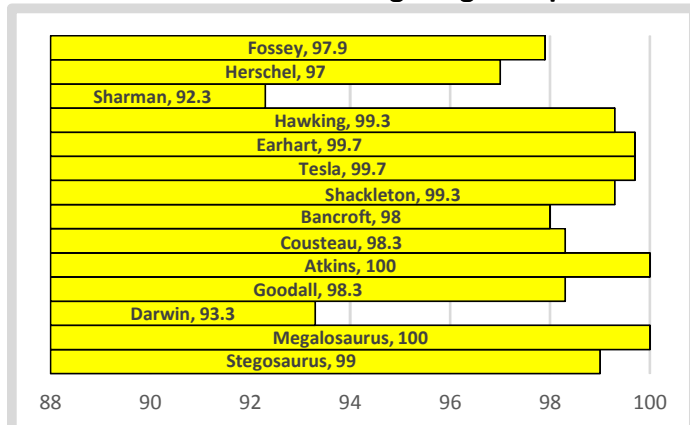

STAY SAFE IN THE SUN!



We are very lucky to have wonderful grounds which we can enjoy to the full during the summer months. However, as a school, we are also aware of the dangers of the sun. We would recommend on sunny days you apply sun cream before the children come to school. If you wish, your child may bring a small bottle of sun cream with them to school. However,

- ◆ The bottle must be labelled with your child's name
- ◆ Your child will be able to apply the cream themselves at times suggested by the teacher (roll-on versions may be easier for your child to manage)
- ◆ The children are not allowed to share bottles of sun cream
- ◆ The bottle must be kept in your child's bag at all other times

All children should also have a named sun hat available at school.

Water is always available from the classroom taps and your child should have a named cup or bottle in school so they can have a drink of water when necessary.
